

Just to Give You an Idea—

The "thousand" that Lowell high's luminary, Carmen Boya, ran in record time of 2.19.7 at the Massachusetts schoolboy meet on Saturday is believed to be the fastest ever reeled off by a schoolboy, as recounted **EXCLUSIVELY** in *The Sun* last night.

Dick Harrington, former Lowell high middle distance star now connected with *The Sun* circulation department, has figured that Boya averaged 13.9 seconds for each 100 yards of the killing distance!

But there is more emphasis to the point.

Glenn Cunningham the greatest distance runner in America and holder of the world record in the mile, won the 1000 yards run at the Seton Hall meet in Newark, N. J. last night.

Cunningham's time was 2.18.6.

Boya's performance therefore is only 1 1-10 seconds off Cunningham's time!
